## Aims:

The Student National Conference, organised by the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities from Sibiu – "New Challenges in the Social Sciences and Humanities at the Beginning of the 3rd Millennium", focuses on supporting partnership and scientific collaboration, bringing together students, academic representatives and researchers in sharing and presenting their research experiences and scientific works on various domains from the social sciences area. We wish to provide the opportunity for interdisciplinary knowledge exchange, academic networking, developing research and new projects between students, raising awareness about the dynamic changes in the society, exploring trends as well as discussing concerns and challenges for the new era while finding solutions.

The conference supports student presentations, studies and papers from the main branches of social sciences and humanities, covering a wide range of fields such as Political Sciences, Security Studies, International Relations, History, Heritage, Protestant Theology, Psychology, Social Work, Human Resources, Sociology, Journalism, Communication and Public Relations, Education sciences.

## Guidelines for participants:

- 1. Abstracts must be sent until the 27<sup>th</sup> of May, 13.00 o'clock.
- 2. Abstracts should follow a given structure: study background, research topic, basic design, major results, conclusions. The total amount of words must not exceed 250 words.
- 3. Students need to fill in either the standard registration form or the online registration form, posted on the conference official website.
- 4. It is recommended that all presentations must be prepared in Power Point format (max. 20 slides).
- 5. Power Point presentations must be sent until the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June, 13.00 o'clock, to the following e-mail address: daniela.stanciu@ulbsibiu.ro.
- 6. Each presenter or team shall be allowed a 15 minutes time slot for the presentation, followed by a 10 minutes time slot for discussions.
- 7. All presentations will take place live online on the institutional Google Meet platform.
- 8. It is advised that participants should use a headset with microphone for a better sound quality and speech.

- 9. Make sure you detain a functional video camera, in order to join the conference with video image.
- 10. Have patience for potential technical challenges and errors that might arise. We shall try to address every technical matter together.
- 11. Respect the communication rules of engagement as you would in a regular conference.
- 12. Decide before the session who is going to post and show the presentation just one representative, even if all the team members will take the floor. You will be asked to share your screen for presenting.
- 13. Mute yourself when entering the meeting room and activate your microphone only when you want to enter the discussion.
- 14. Be on time for each meeting room you want to attend. We ask you to connect 10 minutes in advance to every meeting room or section you want to attend, before it starts.
- 15. All the conference events will follow the Romania local time GMT.
