Aims:

The Student Conference, organised by the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities from Sibiu “New Challenges in the Social Sciences and Humanities at the Beginning of the 3rd Millennium” focuses on supporting partnership and scientific collaboration, bringing together students, academic representatives and researchers in sharing and presenting their research experiences and scientific works on various domains from the social sciences area. We wish to provide the opportunity for interdisciplinary knowledge exchange, academic networking, developing research and new projects between students, raising awareness about the dynamic changes in the society, exploring trends as well as discussing concerns and challenges for the new era while finding solutions.

The conference supports student presentations, studies and papers from the main branches of social sciences and humanities, covering a wide range of fields such as Political Sciences, Security Studies, International Relations, History, Heritage, Conservation and Restoration, Protestant Theology, Psychology, Social Work, Human Resources, Sociology, Journalism, Communication and Public Relations, Education Sciences.

Guidelines for participants:

1. Registration with abstract must be sent until the 18th of May.
2. Abstracts should follow a given structure: study background, research topic, basic design, major results, conclusions. The total amount of words must not exceed 250 words.
3. Students need to fill in the online registration form, posted on the conference official website.
4. Panel coordinators will announce the approval of the paper by email, after the 18th of May.
5. Presentations should be prepared in PowerPoint format (not more than 10 - 15 slides).
6. The PowerPoint presentations (English or German) must be sent until the 25th of May to the panel coordinator, who will contact you by email, if your paper will be accepted.
7. Each presenter or team shall be allowed a 10-15 minutes time slot for the presentation, followed by a 5 minutes time slot for discussions.
8. All presentations will be hosted live online on the institutional Google Meet platform.

9. The organizers recommend participants to use a headset with microphone for a better sound quality.
10. Make sure that you own a functional video-camera, in order to participate to the event with video image.
11. Please be patient if technical problems and errors may occur. We are doing our best to solve them together.
12. Follow the communication rules as in an on site conference.
13. If you are a team, please decide prior to the presentation the person in charge to share the screen and upload the presentation, no matter if all the team members take the floor. Anyhow the time slot remains the same as specified above.
14. Mute your microphone when joining the panel and unmute only when you wish to join the discussion or to ask questions.
15. Be punctual at every panel that you wish to attend. Please connect 10 minutes before the panel starts.
